
Celebrating

How to nominate?

The best way to enter is via our online nomination entry form below.

Categories are open to both prevention and protection teams, receiving separate awards in their area of work

- Choose the category or categories for which you want to nominate the individual or team. If you are entering more than one category, please
 make a separate entry for each category.
- 2. Write an account of no more than 500 words saying why the individual or team should be considered.
- 3. Fill in the online nomination entry form by the closing date, 10th October 2023.

Outstanding Contribution Award

The Outstanding Contribution Award will be presented to an individual who has shown great contribution to the work of prevention or protection. They are a committed individual who goes the extra mile to advocate and enable the development of prevention activity. They have made a significant impact to national prevention or protection work to support the continual improvement of Fire and Rescue Services. As a leader and team player, they are hardworking and dedicated to all areas of prevention or protection.

Partnership Working Award

The Partnership Working Award will be presented to a Fire and Rescue Service who can demonstrate excellence in multi-agency working, and participation in collaboration which has made an improvement to the community they serve.

Team Award

The Team Award will be presented to a team that can demonstrate being productive, approachable, supportive, respectful of others and working collaborative through high performance to achieve their working objectives.

What are the categories?



This award category is open to both Prevention and Protection colleagues

Volunteering Award

The Volunteering Award will be presented to an outstanding volunteer, who exhibits commitment in supporting their Fire and Rescue Service through teamwork and have made an impact in their community by delivering safety education messages. This individual is an ambassador for volunteers and has truly demonstrated that volunteering can help reduce incidents and save lives.

This award category is only open to Prevention colleagues

Children and Young People Award

This award category is for those working within prevention work. The Children and Young People Award will be presented to a Fire and Rescue Service that can demonstrate the positive impact that its work with children and young people has achieved. This could include any engagement or intervention whether it be targeted or universal.
